The publishing opportunities for queer cartoonists and queer subject matter are still limited, even today, and Rob longed for a wider distribution than he was able to manage on his own. He approached Northwest Press about doing a bigger compendium of all-new work. While *THREE* was happening, Justin Hall was preparing his book *No Straight Lines: Four Decades of Queer Comics*, which Fantagraphics published in the summer of 2012. *No Straight Lines* traced the history of queer comics from their humble beginnings in the late 60's/early 70's all the way up to the present.
