(Neil Ollivierre), DJ Stingray/Urban Tribe, Eddie Fowlkies, Terrence Dixon (Population One) and Carl Craig. With references to Theodore Roszak's *Making of a Counter Culture*, writings by African American autoworker and political activist James Boggs, and the techno rebels of Alvin Toffler's *Third Wave*, Brown approaches techno's unique history from a Black theoretical perspective in an effort to evade and subvert the racist and classist status quo in the mainstream musical-historical record.
